COOKIE POLICY

Thank you for visiting the G3G website. We use cookies across our website to enhance your experience. They help us to understand site usage and improve our content, solutions, and service offerings.

Cookies are small text files that we place in your computer's browser to store your preferences. Cookies, by themselves, do not tell us your email address or other personal information unless you choose to provide this information to us by, for example, completing a form on one of our pages. Once you choose to provide a web page with personal information, this information may be linked to the data stored in the cookie

You control the cookies we use

If you want to control which cookies you accept, you can configure your browser to accept all cookies or to alert you every time a cookie is offered by a website's server. Most browsers automatically accept cookies. You can set your browser option so that you will not receive cookies and you can also delete existing cookies from your browser. You may find that some parts of the site will not function properly if you have refused cookies. However, this refusal will not extend to cookies that are essential to allow you to log in or to be remembered by specific services of our website.

What cookies do we use?

The cookies used on our website are categorised in accordance with the International Chamber of Commerce United Kingdom Cookie guide (which can be found on the ICC website), and are as follows:

Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are essential to enable you to move around the website and use its features. Without these cookies, services you have asked for cannot be provided. They are deleted when you close the browser or shortly after.

Performance cookies

These cookies collect information in an anonymous form about how visitors use our website. We use Google Analytics cookies (third party cookies) for the following purposes:

- To record the time of your first visit to the website, the time of your most recent visit to the website and the time of your current visit.
- To record how long you stayed on the website.
- To record how you located our website (i.e., Google search, keyword, link from another page, etc.).

We only share the information obtained through the use of Google Analytics with Google. The analytical cookies we use do not track your Internet usage after leaving our website and do not store your personal information.

Functionality cookies

'Functionality' cookies are used to provide the services you have requested or to remember your settings to improve your visit to our website. We use 'Functionality' cookies to:

- Remember a choice, so as not to be asked again to fill in a questionnaire.
- Fulfil a request by the user, such as submitting a comment.
- Remember settings a user has applied to the website such as start page, theme, layout, font-size, and various other preferences, etc.
